Occupational English Test (OET) opens a new test venue in New Zealand with Massey University

OET, the English language test for healthcare professionals, will be available at a new venue from November 2016. The new Auckland test venue will be managed by Massey University's Centre for Professional and Continuing Education (PaCE).

OET (Occupational English Test) is an Australian-developed English language test which assesses language communication skills of healthcare professionals. It provides assessment of all four language skills – listening, reading, writing and speaking – through test material designed to reflect real healthcare scenarios.

Andrea Flavel, PaCE Director says: "We are committed to providing services and offerings that meet the needs of the communities on the North Shore and wider Auckland area. By offering OET at Massey University, we are enabling health care professionals to demonstrate their English language proficiency for professional registration and employment purposes".

"OET, which is owned by Cambridge English Language Assessment and the Box Hill Institute, has a unique and proven 30 year pedigree in Australia, New Zealand and Singapore. The decision to add the test to our suite was an easy one to make," she concludes.

OET results are accepted by most health regulatory boards and councils in Australia, New Zealand and Singapore as proof of English language proficiency. It is also recognised by the Australian Department of Immigration and Border Protection and Immigration New Zealand for most visa categories.
