PATIENT

TASK

- Tell the radiographer about your claustrophobia and find out if there are any
 ways to make the experience less stressful (you've heard the scanning machine
 is noisy too).
- Finally consent to the procedure, selecting one of the options offered.

RADIOGRAPHER

This nervous patient in his/her late thirties has already had other investigations for chronic back pain.

Examination required: MRI

TASK

- Check the patient's identity.
- Check that he/she knows why he/she is having the scan and what it involves.
- Discuss any concerns with the patient fully and provide reassurance (e.g., explain that you can provide earplugs for noise, non-magnetic earphones and music, even sedation, if required).
