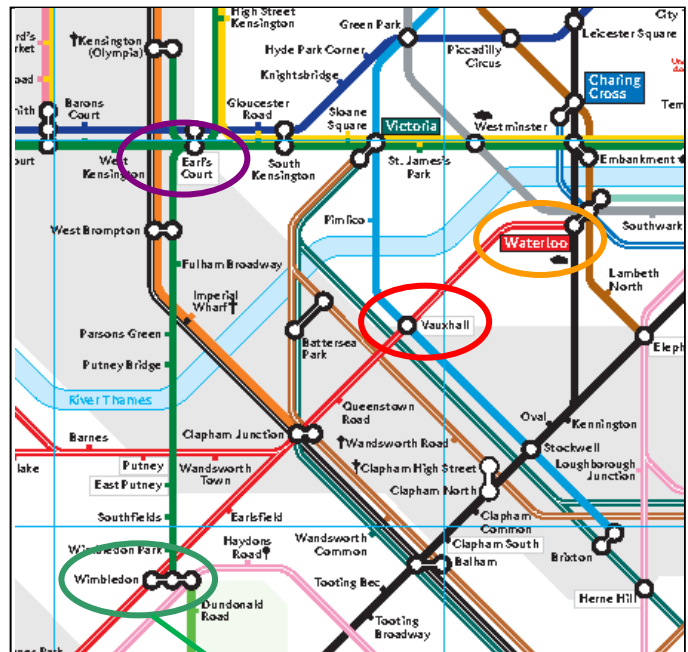

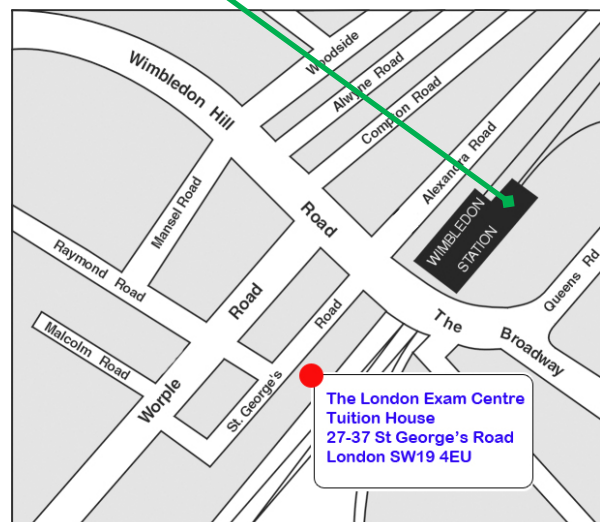

Croydon & Elmers End to Wimbledon Station



Wimbledon Station to The London Exam Centre Office

Exit from Wimbledon Station (main exit – not the shopping centre side), cross the road and walk along Wimbledon Hill Road. Turn left into St George's Road (at Starbucks). Walk along St George's Road and the venue is located on the left side of the road. It is the last building before the bend (passed St George's House). The building has a yellow sign "Tuition House" and it is five-storey high.

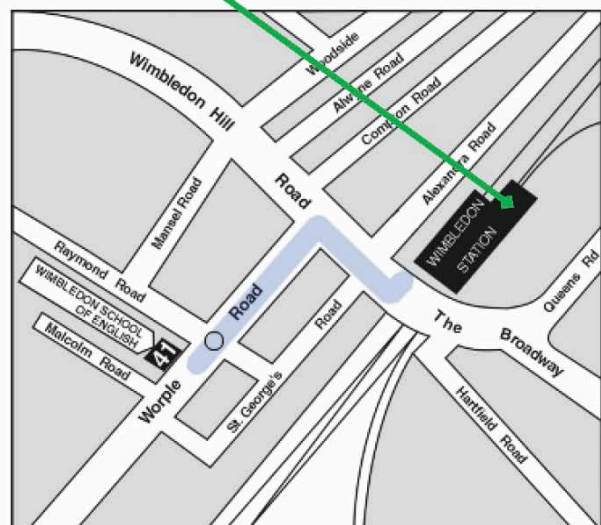
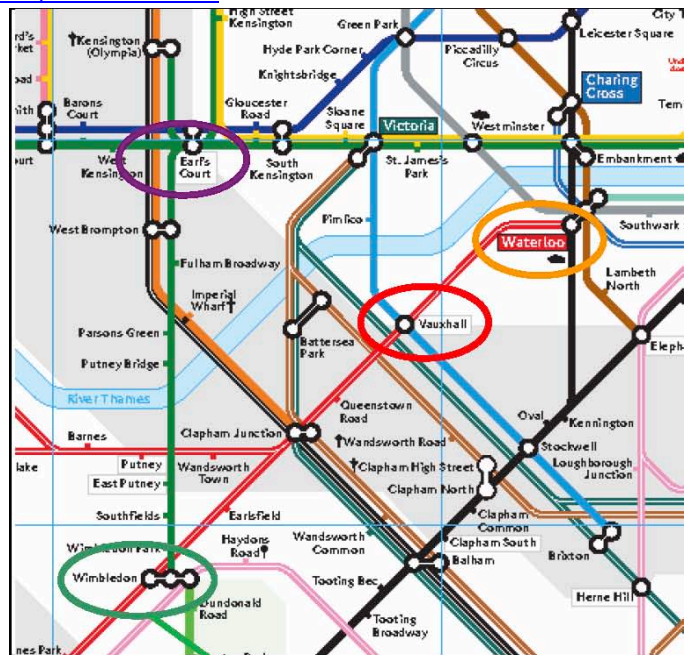

Wimbledon Station to Wimbledon School of English (WSE)

Exit from Wimbledon Station, turn right and walk along Wimbledon Hill Road. Turn left into Worple Road (second corner). Walk along Worple Road to the roundabout, and the school is located on the right side of the road. The school is between Hillside Church and The Justin James Hotel (and opposite British Red Cross and Wimbledon Guild)
